

## Key Stage 4 and 5 Destination Data – July 2017

Pupils in Key Stage 4 have, historically, remained in education either through school 6<sup>th</sup> form or moved on to a local college.

Pupils mostly leave 6<sup>th</sup> form to continue a focussed study at a local college through a foundation course. A small proportion of pupils leave for full time employment each year. Pupils are encouraged to seek part time employment when in the 6<sup>th</sup> form and many have, typically, taken positions in fast food restaurants.
