Curriculum

During the Spring Term we will be covering the following areas - **English**

Our theme is 'Detectives' we will be reading Sherlock Holmes or Shifty McGrifty. We will be looking at features of detective stories and the characters involved. We will also be looking at different word types including nouns, verbs, pronouns, adjectives etc to improve our writing. This work forms part of our coursework, poor attendance can impact completion of units. We will also work on comprehension and spelling skills.

Maths

 Our focus will be on 'Money, Time and Temperature.' We will look at a range of equipment for measuring time and temperature. We will explore negative numbers. Later we will look at money including adding money, rounding money and working out change. This work forms part of our coursework, poor attendance can impact completion of units.

Science

 We will continue to work on the practical element of science. Planning investigations, recording results and drawing conclusions.

Options

As part of our options we will be working on a range of different activities depending on the option chosen. In Art we will continue working on developing painting skills. In D of E we will look at map reading, symbols and working out distances.

Computing

 We will be looking at how we can collect data and analyse it using different software.

<u>RE</u>

 We will be exploring Hinduism and Sikhism this term. We will look at key beliefs and how pilgrimages are important.

PSHCE and Life Skills

• We will learn about healthy lifestyles including how to maintain good mental health. In Life Skills we will learn about credit cards and loans.

Cooking

• We will continue to work on basic cooking skills. Some of us will be looking at hospitality and serving customers.
