Curriculum

English

 We will continue to develop our reading and writing skills through our phonic programme Read, Write Inc. In extended writing we will plan, write and edit fiction and non-fiction texts including descriptive and persuasive genres.

Maths

We will continue working on our basic skills of times tables and number. As well as
revisiting previous learnt concepts, we will develop our written methods involving
multiplication, division and fractions.

Science

• We will explore materials and their properties through experiments and investigations.

Humanities

• Through historical enquiry, we will explore The British Empire both in expansion and reduction. We will look at important figures such as Gandhi. As part of geography, we will learn about the physical and human features of India and study the effects of urbanisation on the country.

Computing

• We will explore email as a form of communication, how to attach documents and keeping safe online.

RE

• The focus this term is on Hinduism and Sikhism. We will examine how the process of worship and rules of religion impact on individual life style and day to day living.

PSHCE and Life Skills

• Our learning will focus on emotional and physical wellbeing through focusing on puberty and concept of consent. We will continue to develop understanding of road safety.

Art

 Through exploration of materials and textures, we will create Indian inspired pieces involving sculptures and drawings.

• In Food, we will continue to learn about food hygiene, consumer awareness and preparing simple dishes with pasta.
