Pupil Premium Fund Financial Year 2017 to 2018

In the 2017 to 2018 financial year, schools will receive the following funding for each child registered as eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years:

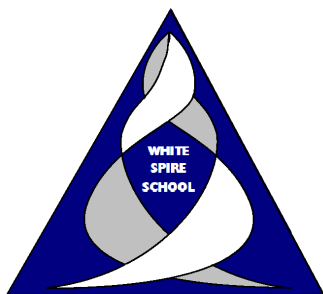
- £1320 for pupils in reception year to year 6
- £935 for pupils in year 7 to year 11

Schools will also receive £1900 for each Looked After Child and post Looked After Child.

Across the whole school to ensure full access to a vibrant and enriching curriculum for all.

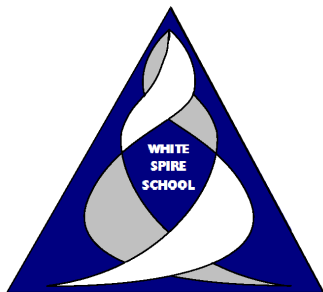
