Pupil Premium

Aims

- Personalisation of learning and focus on the wellbeing of the pupil
- Improvement of attendance
- Training and continuing Professional Development for staff to promote engagement in learning
- Ensure an equal access to a diverse menu of enrichment activity for vulnerable pupils and those experiencing deprivation
- Ensuring that gaps are narrowed between those eligible for the Pupil Premium and other children

Pupil Premium Fund Financial Year 2018 to 2019

In the 2018 to 2019 financial year, schools will receive the following funding for each child registered as eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years:

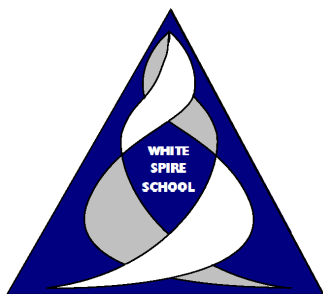
- £1320 for pupils in reception year to year 6
- £935 for pupils in year 7 to year 11

Schools will also receive £2300 for each Looked After Child and post Looked After Child.

Breakfast Club Support

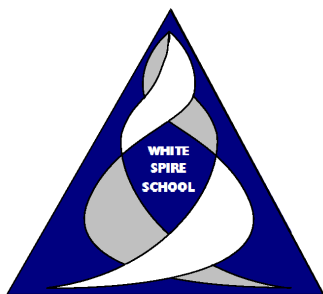
To ensure that any student needing breakfast can be supported.
