## Art Overview

The art progression document will be delivered through a blended learning approach which teaches the knowledge, skills, and concepts of:

- 1. Manipulation Skills
- 2. Physical Representation
- 3. Journey of Development
- 4. Response and Interpretation

All knowledge, skills, and concepts will be delivered through themes via an active, hands on, sensory/kinesthetic experience using a range of art mediums such as paint, pencil, pastels, charcoal, printing, textiles, 3D media including clay and junk modelling. The art curriculum will be enriched through visits from artists and to art installations/galleries.

The pupils' journey of development and interpretation skills in expressing their ideas and opinions (strands 3 and 4) will be entwined with their creation of a wide range of 2D and 3D styles and media (strands 1 and 2).
